Can you provide more information on the Forum Workshops?

There will be three workshops run during the afternoon of the Forum. These are:

- Post-Operation Treatment Pathways (available to all attendees)
- Regulation and Policy (available to all attendees)
- Community Response (for Consumers and Carers only)

The three workshops will be run concurrently, so you will need to choose which one you wish to contribute to. It would be great if you are able to make your decision ahead of the Forum and advise us during registration, so that we can have an early indication on Workshop numbers.
