What accommodation options are near the Citadines Hotel where the event is being held?

The Citadines Hotel has 380 serviced apartments, with equipped kitchenettes, including 19 apartments catering for guests with disability needs. There is a restaurant on site, and a large number of cafes in close proximity to the Hotel. We have arranged a special room rate of \$205 for a Studio Room – quote “Health Issues Centre Mesh Forum” to receive this rate. Alternatively, there are a number of other Apartments and Hotels near Citadines on Bourke.

What are the public transport options to get to the Citadines Hotel?

Use either the 86 or 96 tram which travel along Bourke Street, to Stop 7 (Corner Russell and Bourke Streets). The Citadines on Bourke is approximately 30 metres from this stop. You can catch these trams from the Corner of Spring and Bourke Streets (Stop 9) near Parliament Station if you are coming into the city via train, or from the Corner of Swanston and Bourke Streets (Stop 6) if you arrive at Flinders Street Station.
